Also known as White. Smack, Junk, Powder, Putih, Medicine, Ubat



Harmful Effects

- · Lowered heart rate and respiration
- · Damage to lungs, kidneys and liver
- · Dull feeling and tiredness
- · Difficulty in concentrating

Also known as Marijuana, Pot, Grass,

· Extreme anxiety, depression, confusion and paranoia

· Decline in motivation and drive in long-term abusers

· Constipation

Cannabis

Ganja, Weed

Harmful Effects

· Slow reaction

· Inability to concentrate

· Distorted thinking and perception

· Poor balance and co-ordination

(irrational fear or suspicion)

Methamphetamine

Also known as 'Ice', Glass, Crystal, Speed, Yaba



Harmful Effects

- · Increased heart rate and body temperature
- · Fits, stroke and death
- · Damage to heart and nerves
- · Liver and kidney diseases
- · Abnormal behaviour with mood swings, confusion, delusion and hallucination
- · Anxiety and irritability

Inhalants

Also known as Glue-Sniffina. Solvent Abuse, Solvent Inhalation, Solvent Sniffing



Harmful Effects

- · Permanent damage to brain, liver and kidneys
- · Prone to bleeding and bruises
- · Memory loss
- · Difficulty in learning and seeing things clearly
- · Loss of control of body
- · Cramps, pains and bad cough


Also known as Spice, K2, Bath Salts, Kronic, Bromo-Dragonfly

- · Renal failure

New Psychoactive Substances








- · Hallucination

Together with Captain Drug Buster, Hassan and Ashley, rearrange the jumbled-up words and use the drug fact sheet to find out what drug is affecting Alex.



Melt the ICE


Captain Drug Buster informs Hassan and Ashley that the third tool is trapped within a gigantic ice sculpture at the void deck.


At last, Captain Drug Buster, Hassan and Ashley found Drug Lord! However, he has divided himself into 3 identical forms to confuse them.
