Anti-Drug Skits

Primary Schools

Captain Drug Buster and the evil Dr. Wacko

Adapted from CNB's illustrated book "Captain Drug Buster vs Dr. Wacko: The Final Showdown", the skit serves to educate students on the effects of drugs and how to handle difficult situations when they are lured into the temptation of drugs.

Secondary Schools

What If?

The skit comprises two mini-stories of youths facing the consequences of drug abuse. In the first story, we look at a student who took drugs to cope with stress, and how her bright future could have been ruined by drugs. The second story shows that peer pressure can even come from the person you trust most.

Tertiary Institutions

Too Pop To POP

An interactive skit that offers students an opportunity to be involved in the decision-making process when faced with the temptations of drugs.



Drug Buster Academy

Go on a journey with our Drug Buster Academy (mobile exhibition bus) with hi-tech and futuristic environment for the youths. The use of interactive multimedia exhibits seeks to engage the visitor and create an immersive experience in their learning of the dangers of drug/inhalant abuse.

Assembly Talk

A 45-minute talk presented by experienced CNB Officers with visually impactful videos and educational information on drugs. Hear what these passionate officers have to say about their personal experiences in fighting the drug menace!

*Students who have attended the assembly talk need not attend the sharing session.

Sharing Session

A 30-minute session that allows CNB Officers better engage students at a more intimate level to facilitate more in-depth exchanges. We may also invite former drug abusers to share their personal accounts with students to reinforce the consequences of drug abuse.

CNB Heritage Gallery Visit

Embark on a journey through time, from 1970s where drug abuse was rampant in the streets of Singapore, to a drug-free society we see today. During the visit, you will able to witness the concerted effort between CNB, other government agencies and the community in the fight against drugs.

Talk for Parents & Educators

Parents and educators play an important role in influencing their children/students. This talk is developed to share with parents and educators on issues relating to drug abuse, such as tell-tale signs and myths about drugs.

*Schools are welcome to sign up for this talk for their Parent Support Groups.

Static Exhibition with Mock Drug Display

The static exhibition comprises bite-sized information on the types and harms of drugs, as well as useful tips and tell-tale signs in the form of attractive infographics. There are also mock drug canisters to allow students to view the drugs at a closer distance.
