1) Online Anti-Drug Quiz

This is a joint collaborative effort between CNB and Health Promotion Board (HPB). A series of adventure workshops targeted at Upper Primary and Lower Secondary school students will see students becoming detectives on a hunt to solve substance abuse-related 'crimes' in the **Unmask the Truth Challenge**. Through their investigation, they will learn the impact of smoking, alcohol and drug addiction. The Addiction Mall comprises eight interactive display areas in the setting of a shopping mall to educate
