Fold your own ribbon

If not, you can cut out the ribbon strip on the right, fold it, take a photo of yourself with the ribbon and say something to pledge your support for a drug-free Singapore! - Cut out the ribbon strip on the right and fold it into half along the dotted line. With the #DrugFreeSG as a reference point, fold the paper about 45° up. 2/3 of the paper will be angled like the picture.
- Fold the longer side of the paper 45° down, leaving enough space to tuck the folded side under the other arm of the paper.
- Tuck the folded side under the other arm of the paper. Press neatly along the edges.
